Ten OCC Members in Rim of Pacific Marathon

Among the 297 entrants who officially completed the 1974 Rim of the Pacific Marathon were ten OCC members, including men, women, and children. (If we have inadvertently omitted the name of any member who ran, we are sorry.)

Jan Newhart placed first in the Women's Veterans Division. Her time of 4 hours, 2 minutes, 16 seconds set a new national record for 46-year-old women. Overall she finished 174th.

Sue Stricklin, with a time of 3:51:46, placed second in the Women's Masters Division. Overall, she was 149th to complete the 26-mile, 385-yard course.

OCC member Morton Mandel placed 11th in the Men's Veterans Division and finished 192nd overall. His time was 4:14:22. Dr. Jack Scaff finished 69th overall with a time of 3 hours, 22 minutes, 22 seconds.

Bill Stricklin IV, eleven years old, came in 277th overall with a time of 5:31:56. His brother John, eight years old, finished 292nd in six hours, seven minutes, 41 seconds. Father Bill Stricklin came in 70th in the Open Division and 203rd overall with a time of 4:18:32.

Outrigger members Bill Burgess, Fred Hemmings, Jr., and Bruce Ames finished 161st, 241st, and 286th respectively.
